Under 'colour', write 'green' or 'purple' etc

Under 'lobed?', put a tick under 'no' or write the number of lobes under 'number'.

Under 'points?', put a tick under 'no' or write the number of points under 'number'.

Under 'serrated?', put a tick under 'no' if the leaf has a smooth edge or under 'yes' if the leaf has a jagged edge (like tiny teeth on a saw).

Under 'hairy?', put a tick under 'no' if the leaf has no hairs on it, or under 'above' or 'below' if it is hairy.

Under 'compound?', put a tick under 'no' if the leaf is simple, or under 'pinnate' or 'palmate' if it is a compound leaf.

Under 'leaf or leaflet shape', put a tick under the word that best describes the shape of your leaf or leaflets.
