Colour: white silver light grey dark grey grey
light brown dark brown red green yellow pink

Texture: smooth thin lines across curved lines
dark circles feels like toast deep cracks between thick strips
 thin shallow cracks up and down curved cracks very rough
black patches papery flakes hard rounded shapes
network of ridges.

Branching

Whole-tree shape: bell tall sausage egg egg on its side

Branches: curved straight zigzag

Buds

Colour: black brown green

Shape: long short thin chubby straight
curved pointed egg-shaped.

Position: opposite each other at the tip on each side
only on 2 sides clustered at the end
